

Gorkha – August

In Gorkha, General Chhetris and Dalits tend to be the most positive groups, especially towards government support. However, Gurungs and Janajatis are much more positive towards NGOs than other groups (they are the majority groups).

Generally, the youngest age ground (15-24) is the most positive across all questions. And women have a tendency to be more positive than men in Gorkha.

No group feels very positive about being hear, which reflects the lowest levels of positive response. Of all ethnic groups on this, the Dalits and the Brahmins are the most negative.

Question 1: Are your main problems being addressed?

Not at all – 34%; Not very much – 2%; Neutral – 18%; Mostly yes – 33%; Completely yes – 13%; Don't know/refused – 1%

- Women – 28% negative, 23% neutral and 46% positive;
Men – 41% negative, 13% neutral and 46% positive
- Brahmin – 59% negative, 41% positive
Chhetri – 22% negative, 78% positive
Gurung – 63% negative, 37% positive
Janajati – 60% negative, 40% positive
Newar – 40% negative, 60% positive

Dalit – 42% negative, 58% positive

Other/Tamang – 67% negative, 33% positive

- 15-24 – 30% negative, 70% positive
25-39 – 60% negative, 40% positive
40-54 – 50% negative, 50% positive
55+ – 60% negative, 40% positive

Of the 54% of people in Gorkha who responded that their main problems were not being addressed, the top problems they identified were: long-term shelter (45), clean water and sanitation (16) and financial support (13).

Question 2: Are you satisfied with what the government is doing?

Not at all – 30%; Not very much – 3%; Neutral – 7%; Mostly yes – 38%; Completely yes – 22%; Don't know/refused – 1%

- Women – 28% negative, 13% neutral and 57% positive;
Men – 35% negative, .5% neutral and 63% positive
- Brahmin – 35% negative, 65% positive
Chhetri – 22% negative, 78% positive
Gurung – 50% negative, 50% positive
Janajati – 55% negative, 35% positive, 1 person refused
Newar – 10% negative, 90% positive
Dalit – 8% negative, 92% positive
Other/Tamang – 67% negative, 33% positive
- 15-24 – 20% negative, 80% positive
25-39 – 47% negative, 53% positive
40-54 – 31% negative, 69% positive
55+ – 50% negative, 50% positive

Of the 40% of people who responded that they were not satisfied with government services, the main things they wanted from government included: cash for work (85%) and building materials (73%).

Question 3: Do you have the information you need to get relief and support?

Not at all – 15%; Not very much – 3%; Neutral – 21%; Mostly yes – 22%; Completely yes – 34%; Don't know/refused – 6%

- Women – 35% negative, 24% neutral and 56% positive (3 people refused)
Men – 31% negative, 16% neutral and 56% positive (3 people refused)
- Brahmin – 53% negative, 47% positive
Chhetri – 22% negative, 78% positive
Gurung – 42% negative, 58% positive
Janajati – 50% negative, 35% positive (3 refused)
Newar – 20% negative, 70% positive (1 refused)
Dalit – 25% negative, 58% positive (2 refused)
Other/Tamang – 33% negative, 68% positive
- 15-24 – 10% neutral, 90% positive
25-39 – 36% negative, 57% positive (3 refused)
40-54 – 47% negative, 47% positive (2 refused)
55+ – 50% negative, 40% positive (1 refused)

Of the 39% of people who did not feel they have the information they need to get relief and support, the top information needs were: news about government decisions (51%) and how to register for support (46%).

Question 4: Are you satisfied with what NGOs are doing for you?

Not at all – 15%; Not very much – 8%; Neutral – 11%; Mostly yes – 44%; Completely yes – 22%; Don't know/refused – 1%

- **Women – 15% negative, 6% neutral and 74% positive (1 person refused)**
Men – 30% negative, 13% neutral and 57% positive
- Brahmin – 71% negative, 29% positive
Chhetri – 44% negative, 56% positive
Gurung – 12% negative, 88% positive
Janajati – 15% neutral, 85% positive
Newar – 20% negative, 70% positive (1 refused)
Dalit – 50% negative, 50% positive
Other/Tamang – 44% negative, 56% positive
- **15-24 – 40% negative, 60% positive**
25-39 – 13% negative, 33% positive (1 refused)
40-54 – 14% negative, 18% positive
55+ – 30% negative, 70% positive

Of the 34% of people who responded that they were not satisfied with NGO services, the main things they wanted from NGOs included: cash for work (73%) and building materials (71%).

Question 5: Is support being provided in a fair way?

Not at all – 14%; Not very much – 9%; Neutral – 12%; Mostly yes – 39%; Completely yes – 25%; Don't know/refused – 2%

- Women – 8% negative, 20% neutral and 67% positive (1 don't know, 1 refused)
Men – 35% negative, 5% neutral and 59% positive
- Brahmin – 53% negative, 47% positive
Chhetri – 44% negative, 56% positive
Gurung – 16% negative, 84% positive
Janajati – 30% negative, 65% positive (1 refused)
Newar – 30% neutral, 70% positive
Dalit – 50% negative, 50% positive
Other/Tamang – 33% negative, 55% positive (1 don't know)
- 15-24 – 40% negative, 60% positive
25-39 – 27% negative, 70% positive (1 don't know)
40-54 – 44% negative, 56% positive
55+ – 40% negative, 60% positive

Of the 35% of people in Gorkha who believe aid is not provided in a fair way, the top responses to explain this are: political parties (29%) and joint families (31%).

Question 6: Are you prepared for the monsoon?

Not at all – 17%; Not very much – 3%; Neutral – 10%; Mostly yes – 31%; Completely yes – 39%; Don't /refused – 1%

- Women – 11% negative, 11% neutral and 78% positive;
Men – 28% negative, 7% neutral and 63% positive
- Brahmin – 47% negative, 53% positive
Chhetri – 22% negative, 78% positive
Gurung – 17% negative, 83% positive
Janajati – 40% negative, 60% positive
Newar – 30% negative, 70% positive
Dalit – 25% negative, 75% positive
Other/Tamang – 22% negative, 67% positive (1 refused)
- 15-24 – 20% negative, 80% positive
25-39 – 30% negative, 70% positive
40-54 – 31% negative, 38% positive
55+ – 40% negative, 60% positive

Question 7: Do you feel you've been heard?

Not at all – 31%; Not very much – 7%; Neutral – 19%; Mostly yes – 32%; Completely yes – 5%; Don't know/refused – 7%

- Women – 33% negative, 17% neutral and 41% positive (4 refused)
Men – 41% negative, 20% neutral and 33% positive (3 refused)
- Brahmin – 71% negative, 29% positive
Chhetri – 44% negative, 56% positive
Gurung – 58% negative, 25% positive (4 refused)
Janajati – 50% negative, 45% positive (1 refused)
Newar – 30% negative, 60% positive (1 refused)
Dalit – 75% negative, 25% positive
Other/Tamang – 5 negative, 3 positive (1 refused)
- 15-24 – 50% negative, 40% positive (1 refused)
25-39 – 55% negative, 45% positive (3 refused)
40-54 – 59% negative, 34% positive (2 refused)
55+ – 60% negative, 20% positive (1 refused)

Question 8: Overall, is the earthquake response making progress?

Not at all – 18%; Not very much – 3%; Neutral – 22%; Mostly yes – 28%; Completely yes – 29%; Don't know/refused – 1%

- Women – 11% negative, 26% neutral and 63% positive;
Men – 30% negative, 20% neutral and 50% positive (1 refused)
- Brahmin – 59% negative, 41% positive
Chhetri – 33% negative, 67% positive
Gurung – 54% negative, 46% positive
Janajati – 30% negative, 70% positive
Newar – 20% neutral, 70% positive (1 refused)
Dalit – 42% negative, 58% positive
Other/Tamang – 44% negative, 56% positive
- 15-24 – 30% negative, 70% positive
25-39 – 47% negative, 53% positive

40-54 – 47% negative, 50% positive (1 refused)

55+ – 30% negative, 70% positive

Question 9: As a woman, are your main problems being addressed?

Not at all – 26%; Not very much – 7%; Neutral – 24%; Mostly yes – 24%; Completely yes – 15%; Don't know/refused – 6%

- Brahmin – 100% negative, 0% positive
Chhetri – 20% neutral, 80% positive
Gurung – 50% negative, 42% positive (1 refused)
Janajati – 58% negative, 33% positive (1 refused)
Newar – 67% neutral, 33% positive
Dalit – 75% negative, 25% positive
Other/Tamang – 60% negative, 40% positive
- 15-24 – 33% negative, 67% positive
25-39 – 58% negative, 42% positive
40-54 – 78% negative, 11% positive (1 refused)
55+ – 40% neutral, 40% positive (1 don't know)

Of the 57% of women in Gorkha who responded that their women's specific needs were not being met, the main needs raised were: long term shelter (40%) and financial support (24%)
